CIHC is an ICF Level 1 training created by Intermountain Health and Hudson Institute of Coaching, standard bearers in the fields of healthcare leadership development and developmental coaching, respectively. Graduates are qualified coaches with specialized training in healthcare strategies.

What is CIHC?

Program basics

This program produces skilled developmental coaches who specialize in healthcare.

Derived from Hudson's prestigious executive coach certification, it spans coaching foundations to advanced competencies. Graduates will be equipped to engage with clients from any field and deeply practiced in healthcare strategies.



Gold-standard coach curriculum, authored through a healthcare lens

- Grounded in established adult development theory & coaching methodology
- Experiential learning with real healthcare leadership scenarios
- Integration of clinical and operational case studies
- Personalized facilitation and guidance from ICF-certified coaches supporting leaders in healthcare



65 hours of experiential learning, clinics, and mentor coaching

Over 3 to 4 months participants will attend one in-person intensive – held at Intermountain Health's Salt Lake City campus – and two live, virtual intensives.

Participants will graduate ready to practice Hudson's developmental coaching methodology in a healthcare context.

- Virtual Intensives: May 12-13, 2026 & June 17-18, 2026
- Interim Learning between onsite and virtual intensives



Pathway to Credential

Participants graduate the program on their way to ICF's ACC credential.

Education Hours

65 hours of Coaching Education Training (80% of content focused on the ICF Core Competencies) 2

Mentor Coaching

10 hours of mentor coaching (7 group and 3 individual)

Recording and submission of a complete coaching session lasting 30 minutes

100+ hours of coaching experience within the 18 months prior to submitting the credential application



Application

Apply to the ICF for the ACC credential - Level 1 pathway



Credentialing Exam

Pass a computer-based written exam. The exam is designed to measure a coach's knowledge of and ability to apply the ICF definition of coaching, ICF Core Competencies and ICF Code of Ethics

- Embed developmental leadership principles system-wide






Pricing & Enrollment
